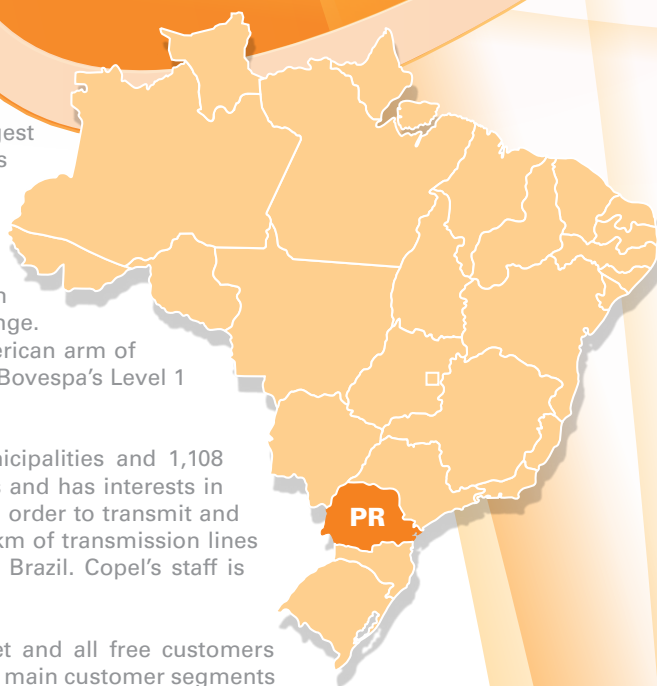
Corporate Profile

Copel – Companhia Paranaense de Energia – generates, transmits, distributes and sell electric in the State of Paraná, being one of the largest electric power companies in Brazil. The Company's position in the sector is a result of 54 years of experience and technical proficiency in generating, transmitting and distributing electric power.

Copel went public in April 1994 on Bolsa de Valores de São Paulo – BOVESPA - and, in July 1997, became the first company of the Brazilian electric power sector with shares traded on the New York Stock Exchange. Copel's shares are also traded, in Europe, on the Latibex – the Latin American arm of the Madrid Stock Exchange, since June 2002. In May 2008 COPEL joined Bovespa's Level 1 of Corporate Governance.

Currently, Copel directly serves 3,571,243 customers units in 393 municipalities and 1,108 localities (districts, villas and villages). Copel holds 18 own power plants and has interests in other 7 generation companies, totaling 5,160 MW of installed capacity. In order to transmit and distribute the electric power generated, the Company counts on 1,866.5 km of transmission lines and 178,988 km of distribution lines, being the third largest network in Brazil. Copel's staff is composed by 8,527 employees.

Copel Distribuição's grid market (TUSD), comprising the captive market and all free customers within the Company's concession area, grew by 2.5% in this semester. The main customer segments changed as follows: residential, 5.1%; commercial, 6.9%; industrial, -4.0%; and rural 6.4%



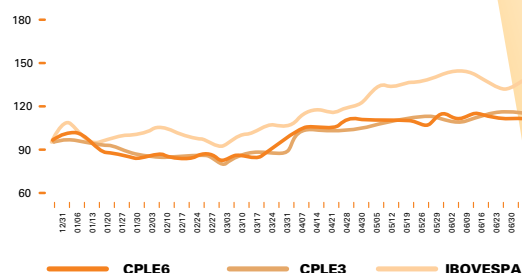

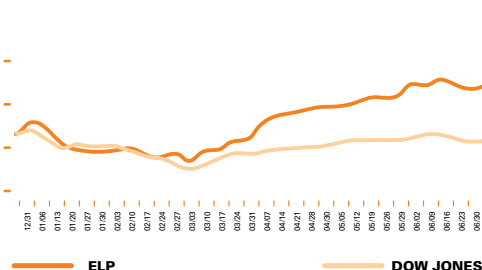

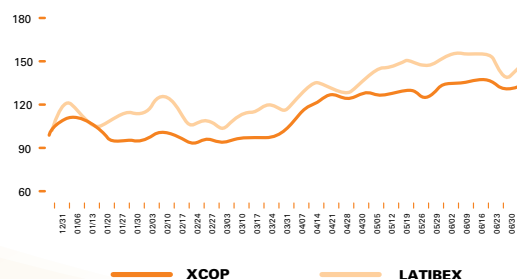
STOCK PERFORMANCE AT BOVESPA
12/31/08 = 100



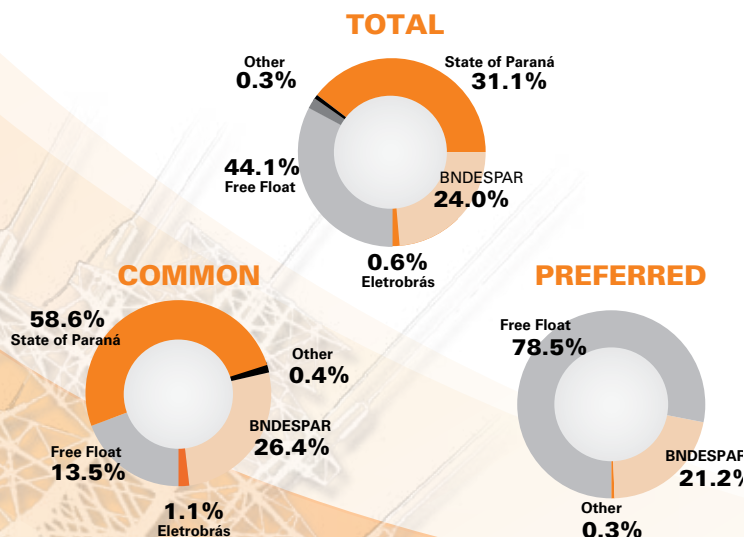
ADR's PERFORMANCE AT NYSE

12/31/08 = 100

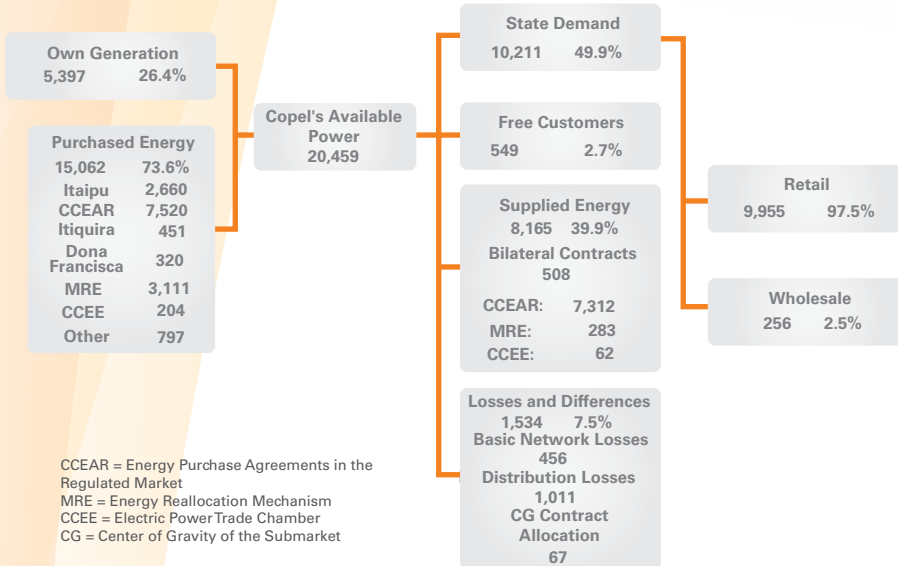


Ownership Breakdown

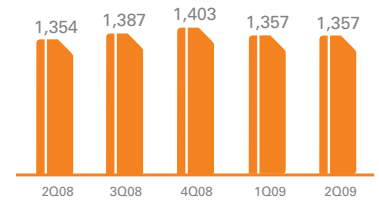


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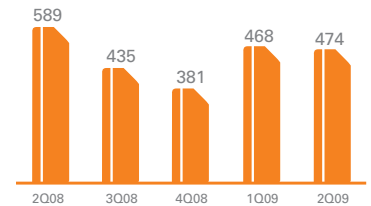
Consolidated Energy Flow



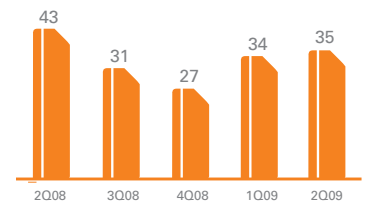
Net Operating Revenue (R\$ million)



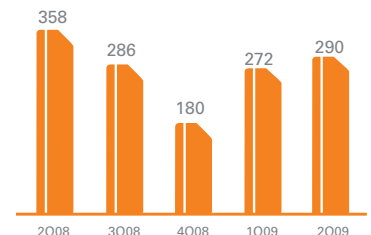
EBITDA (R\$ million)



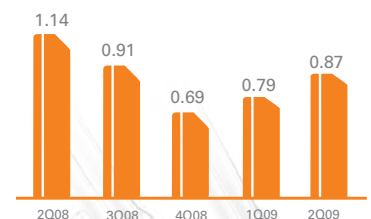
EBITDA Margin (%)



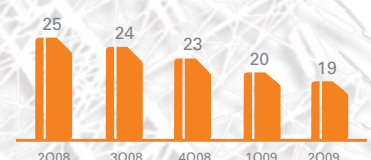
Net Income (R\$ million)
